

Stewardship Committee Meeting Notes
March 1, 2022



The first task was to review the current pledge information. As of 3/1, Highland had received 153 pledges, totaling \$562,491. This represents 75% of last year's total. The average pledge is \$3,676.

Members of the committee had begun to make follow-up contacts with members who had pledged in the past. To date, 12 additional pledges have been returned, totaling \$15,000. Two members of the committee had not been made. [Between the meeting of the committee on 3/1 and the meeting of the session on 3/16, several additional pledges have been returned. Total will be available at the session meeting.]

There have been members who have indicated that they will not be pledging this year, due to events last fall. Some have declined because of their disappointment at the resignation of the former associate pastor and some because they felt church was not acting responsibly in granting such a large severance. One of the committee members reported that some of these members who have declined to pledge shared appreciation that they were contracted and listened to.

The original list of people or pledging units (families) to be contacted was 104.
