for the cry of the voiceless,

for the groaning of the weary,

for the pain of the wounded,

for the sigh of the victim,

for the laughter of children,

for the song of gladness,

knowing that your Spirit, your Holy Spirit, enables crying, groaning, sighing,

and also brings song and laughter.

Silence is kept

Reader 4: We will be still,

and if we do not take off our shoes,

we will yet remember that this is Holy Ground because you have promised to be
where your people meet in Jesus' name.

And so we will wait;

patiently or impatiently

we will wait for Jesus. **Amen.**

Scripture Reading *Psalm 71:*

Reader 1: In you, O God, is my security;
let me never be put to shame.

By your saving power deliver me, hear me and keep me safe.

Reader 2: Be a rock of refuge for me
to which I can always come.

Keep me safe from the power of the wicked, from the grasp of the cruel and unjust.

Reader 3: In you, as long as I can remember,
my hope and my trust have been placed.

I have leaned on you since my birth, since you brought me out of the womb.

Reader 4: Keep close when energy fails me
and I spend my last years on earth.

Let me wait in continual hope and praise you again and again.
