2. Speaker schedule on the theme of Community, Conflict, and Understanding:
 - January 15 after-church luncheon: Aimee Moiso will discuss conflict and Christian faith. Megan arranged to have HPC member Pam Osborne cater the luncheon, drawing from the Congregational Meals budget. Linda wrote promotion copy for the newsletter. Nolan volunteered to serve as emcee and to locate a quality projector, and Joanie McGuire suggested that 3x5 cards be placed on tables for people to write their questions. The cards should be saved because they might serve as an index to people's concerns.

 - April 23 after-church luncheon: Troy Burden, Executive Director at Highlands Community Ministries, will discuss needs in the Highlands.
